On Thursday 3/14/2013 at approx. 2210 hours I, Cpl. Gary, responded to the South GA Tech school campus Martin hall in reference to a fight.

Upon arrival there was no active fight in progress. I made contact with Basketball coach James Frey, the complainant and witness. He stated he drove up to Martin hall where he witnessed a large group of males get in a fight which involved a baseball bat. He stated he was near his car in the parking area when he observed several males standing outside the entrance way. He stated he observed another group of males arrive in an older box style car and get out and approach the first group near the entrance. He said he saw the two groups converge and start fighting. He said he saw one subject strike another with a baseball bat and several others fighting on the ground next to the entrance to the building.

After talking to him he took me upstairs inside the building where he showed me the following males whom he stated were students involved in the fight: Ahmaud Arbery, Jabari Parker (aka "Black"), and Ontario Bell.

Arbery was one of the persons struck with the baseball bat and was bleeding from the left side of his head above the hair line. He refused medical attention from the responding Vital Care EMS unit. He was uncooperative when asked for details about the incident. He did state he was unsure of the identity of the male who stuck him with the baseball bat. After learning that the incident was on video he admitted to having retrieved two pair of pliers for himself and Bell to use for the fight.

Parker would only give me his personal information and seemed to have a hard time talking and was also unsteady on his feet. He remained silent when asked about his involvement in the incident. He had visible scratch marks to his nose. He was not present when EMS arrived but didn't want a ride to the hospital or EMS called back to check him out. Coach Frey stated he was "beat down to the ground" by several males but it is unknown if he was hit with a weapon.

Bell at first gave me his personal information and no details about the fight. He also appeared to have no visible injuries that I could see to his person. After reviewing the security footage of the incident Chief of campus safety, Sammy Stone talked to Bell and he agreed to show myself and the Chief where a pair of pliers that were used in the fight were located. He lead Chief Stone and myself to the area the fight occurred where a pair of blue and orange handle pliers with a silver head were located. I photographed the pliers where they were found then using latex gloves picked them up and placed them into a brown paper evidence bag. The pliers will be placed into the evidence drop box at the Lec.

Chief Stone showed myself, Dep. Hale (448), and Coach Frey the video footage of the incident. In the video we were

able to see approx. 8 or more black males gather outside of the entrance to Martin hall. Suspects Arbery, Parker, and Bell were identified on the video by the coach and the chief. In the video you could see Ahmaud Arbery hand Ontario Bell a pair of pliers and all the males stood around the entrance for several minutes until you could see an older box style car and a smaller silver car drive up to Martin hall. And unknown number of black males exited the two cars according to Coach Frey and the two groups approached each other then started the fight. Chief Stone stated he would have the footage downloaded and try to identify all the parties involved on the video and pass along all the information he gathers to the Sheriff's Office next date along with a copy of the video.

While at the scene Dep. Hale was contacted by Ofc. Gator of the Americus Police dept. (APD) who was at the Phoebe Sumter E.R. in reference to an assault call. Dep. Hale arrived at the hospital and made contact with Rickey Simmons who had several severe looking wounds to his forehead and face. He was bleeding heavily. I made contact with Mr. Simmons and took pictures of his injuries and the large amount of blood on his chest and feet. There was also pile of clothing at the foot of his bed covered in blood which was removed by the E.R. staff. He told us he was involved in an altercation with a group of subjects from the Tech school at Univ. apartments along with other friends of his and his brother Shawn Simmons. He stated the group came looking for trouble and wanted to fight. He stated they left the area and he and his friends then followed them to the Tech school with and unknown number of people in two cars. He stated he didn't know who had the baseball bat and thought he was hit by one of the pairs of pliers used in the incident. The E.R. staff advised he would need numerous stitches to his head and face. End of report.
